Bilirubin Test Report Format

Normal Range of Bilirubin

Test Type	Normal Range	Unit	Reference Values
Total Bilirubin	0.3 - 1.2	mg/dL	Normal values may vary by age and sex
Direct Bilirubin	0.1 - 0.3	mg/dL	Elevated levels may indicate liver or bile duct issues
Indirect Bilirubin	0.2 - 0.8	mg/dL	Higher levels may indicate hemolysis or liver dysfunction

What Do the Results Mean?

Interpreting the bilirubin test results depends on the following:

- **Elevated Total Bilirubin**: High levels may indicate liver disease or bile duct obstruction.
